BSVC offers financial assistance to families through a need based priority system and first come, first serve until the allotment is out. All scholarships are issued for the current season only.

We ask that a parent or athlete prepare a letter written to the directors and the board of directors stating:

1. What special reasons do you have for needing a scholarship?
2. What does being part of BSVC mean to you?
3. What is your mother and father's yearly salary? Single income and double income family?
4. In order to receive this scholarship, you must volunteer to work the Best of the West volleyball tournament in Bozeman. Can you work these days to earn your scholarship? This would entail concessions, set up, gate entry, etc.

All applications are reviewed by the Board of Directors and Club Director. The number of scholarships granted and the amounts funded are determined by the BOD based need and available funds. Every effort will be made to give fair and equal treatment to all club member applicants. Scholarship applicant information will be kept in the strictest confidence.

Receiving financial assistance from BSVC does not guarantee a spot on any of our teams. If an athlete is selected to a team and does not finish the season for any reason, the responsible party for the athlete will be responsible for paying remaining fees,

including reimbursing the full scholarship amount.
